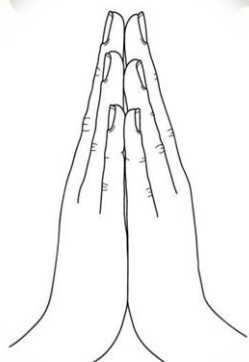
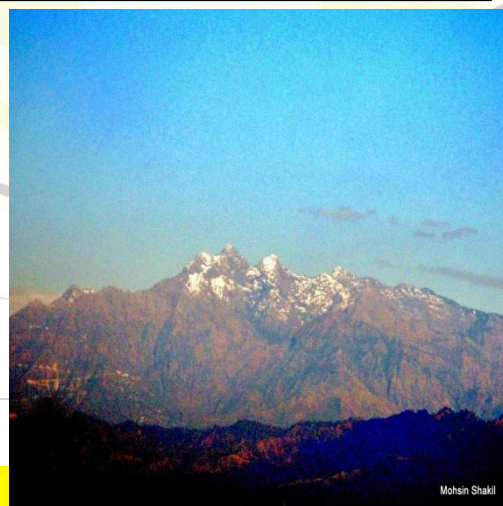

SDM Chowki Choura reviews dev activities

JAMMU, Apr 8: Sub Divisional Magistrate (SDM) Chowki Choura, Virender Gupta, along with Tehsildar, Dr Raman Jandyal, performed a range of developmental activities today.

One of the activities was a mega job fair held in the SDM Office complex. The Institute of Hotel Management officials conducted an awareness camp for unemployed youths in the area, introducing them to various short-term and free-of-cost courses, including an entrepreneurship program and Hunarse-Rozgar-Tak course.

Participants were also made aware of a 1.5 year Diploma Course for a minimal fee of Rs 30,000, which would provide them with 100% placement in various one-star hotels in the country, as well as employment opportunities in foreign countries.

The SDM, along with the Tehsildar and revenue team, also conducted an anti-encroachment drive to remove

foundations raised for commercial purposes on State Land.

Meanwhile, the SDM Chowki Choura claimed in a statement that Tourism Department has agreed to construct an amusement park at Chowki Choura.

He said, a piece of land measuring 4 Kanals and 16 Marlas in Village Chowki was proposed to the Tourism Department to construct the amusement park.

Accordingly, he said, today, the executive engineer of the department visited the site and was shown the vacated piece of land. It was divulged that a sum of Rs 90 lakh has been proposed by the Tourism Department in their budget for the amusement park.

Once the funds are released, the SDM Chowki Choura said that tenders shall be floated for early execution of work. The amusement park, he said, would be a boon for the pilgrim-tourists visiting Shahdra Sharief, Shiv Khori, and Buddha Amarnath Shrine.

JKP signs MoU with FCI to train NoK of martyrs

JAMMU, Apr 10: Jammu and Kashmir Police (JKP) today signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Food Craft Institute (FCI) in order to provide skill development training to the Next of the Kin (NoK) of the martyrs.

Under the agreement, FCI, Jammu will design course, train, do assessment and certification of trainees for creating employability and sustainable livelihood. The selected candidates will go under one and half year diploma course in different streams that includes food production, food and beverage operations, bakery and confectionary, front office and reception, and housekeeping and

maintenance.

As per a statement, the objective of the MoU signed by DIG Administration PHQ, Sarah Rizvi, is to encourage entrepreneurship amongst the NoK of the martyrs of J&K Police for their rehabilitation.

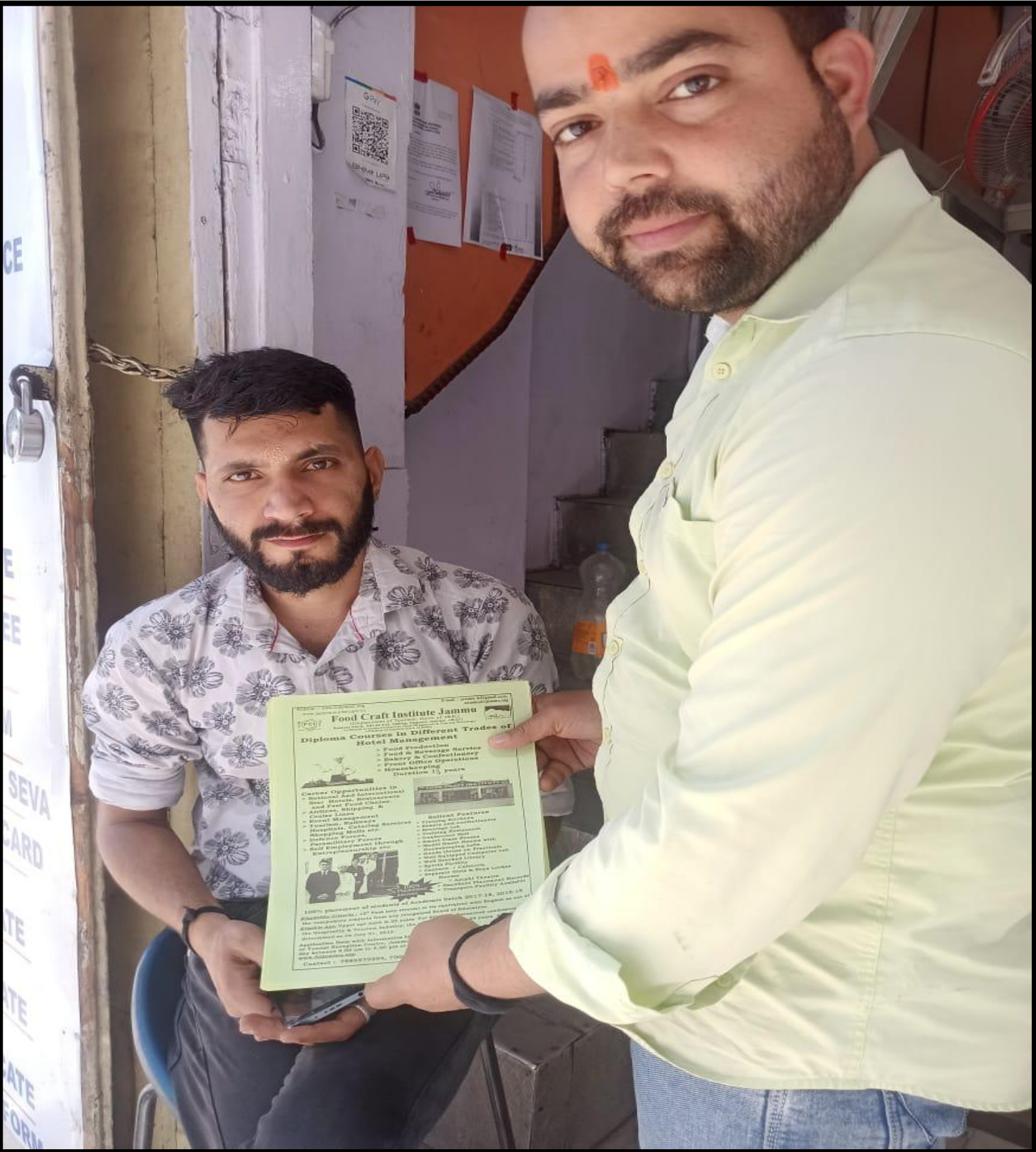
"The wards of serving police personnel shall also be considered for the same skill development programme in due course of time," reads the press statement.
