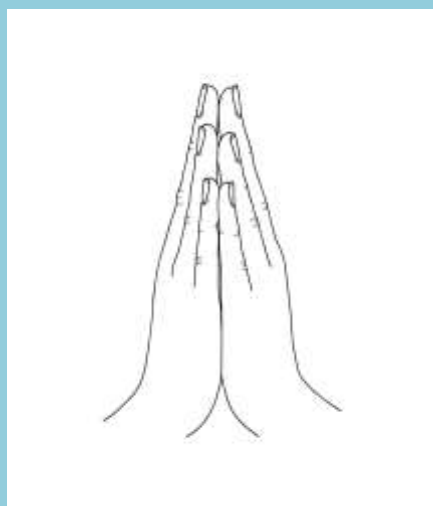

Dear Palvi,

The Living Adventure WLL (the "Employer") is a project specific limited liability company registered in Qatar. The Employer will provide temporary accommodation services ("Project") for a Global Sporting Event which will be held in Qatar between 21 November 2022 and 28 December 2022. The Project is of a fixed duration because all temporary accommodation services will come to an end in January 2023 ("Project End Date").

This letter ("Offer Letter") sets out the terms and conditions of employment being offered to you by the Employer. Once signed, and once all of the conditions set out in this Offer Letter have been fulfilled, this document will become your employment agreement for the period of your employment.

1. Position:	Room Attendant
2. Reporting to:	You will report to Floor Supervisor.
3. Employment Status:	Your employment is SINGLE status.
4. Period of Employment:	Limited to the period commencing from the Hire Date to 31 January 2023.
5. Hire Date:	15 MARCH 2022 or such date as shall be determined and agreed by both, you and the Employer.
6. Point of Hire:	Jammu, India
7. Basic Salary:	Your monthly basic salary will be QAR 2,000 paid on a monthly basis on or around 28th of the month. There is currently no personal income tax in Qatar. In the event that the income tax law changes in the course of your employment, you accept that any such taxes which apply to you shall be borne by you.
8. Accommodation & Meals:	You will be accommodated in a TRIPLE Sharing room in the employee housing complex for the period of Employment only. You acknowledge that you have no right to remain in the employee housing complex after your employment has been terminated for whatever reason. Accommodation utilities will be paid by the Employer as well as three (3) meals per day provided by the Employer.
9. Transportation:	The Employer will provide you transportation between the employee housing complex and the work site(s).
10. Uniform & Laundry:	You will be provided with a uniform including the entitlement to have your uniform dry-cleaned via the Employer.





- 11. Medical Insurance:** You will be entitled to join the Employer's Employee Medical Insurance Plan (the "Plan") providing you with appropriate medical coverage. Full details of the Plan will be provided to you on or about your Hire Date.
- 12. Working Hours:** Your normal working hours will be forty-eight (48) hours per week, exclusive of break time; which is eight (8) hours a day, six (6) days a week. Please note that working hours are scheduled based on business needs. Due to the nature of the Project and your responsibilities, you may be required to work additional hours, which will be compensated according to the Qatar Labour Law (Law No.14 of 2004 as amended).
- 13. Leave & Holidays** You will be entitled to public holidays as announced by the Qatar Government for the Employer or appropriate time off in lieu and/or overtime, depending upon the requirements of your position.
You shall be also entitled to a leave of absence by reason for sickness, injury or other incapacity, in accordance with the Qatar Labour Law, provided that you comply with the Company's sickness notification requirements.
- 14. Relocation:** You will be provided with a (1) one-way economy class ticket from your Point of Hire to Doha upon Date of Hire provided that all legal requirements are met to qualify you for a work permit in Qatar. Locally hired applicants are not entitled for relocation flight.
- 15. Repatriation:** At the end of your Period of Employment you will be entitled to a (1) one-way economy class ticket from Doha to your Home Destination unless otherwise agreed. If the Employee finds an employment opportunity within Qatar the repatriation flight ticket will not be applicable.
- 16. Repatriation:** At the end of your Period of Employment you will be entitled to a (1) one-way economy class ticket from Doha to your Home Destination **Jammu, India** unless otherwise agreed. If the Employee finds an employment opportunity within Qatar, the repatriation flight ticket will not be applicable.

General Terms

17. Pre-Conditions of Employment

The terms of this Offer Letter, any associated employment agreement and your employment will be conditional upon the successful completion of all necessary background checks and legal requirements needed to qualify you for and continue to qualify you for a Qatar work permit and residence permit to allow you to legally work and reside in Qatar, including successfully completing a medical examination and fingerprint check. You agree to provide the Employer promptly with such documents, information and assistance as it may require in obtaining or in any way dealing with your work and residence permits. The Employer will take all reasonable steps required to obtain a work and residence permit for you.

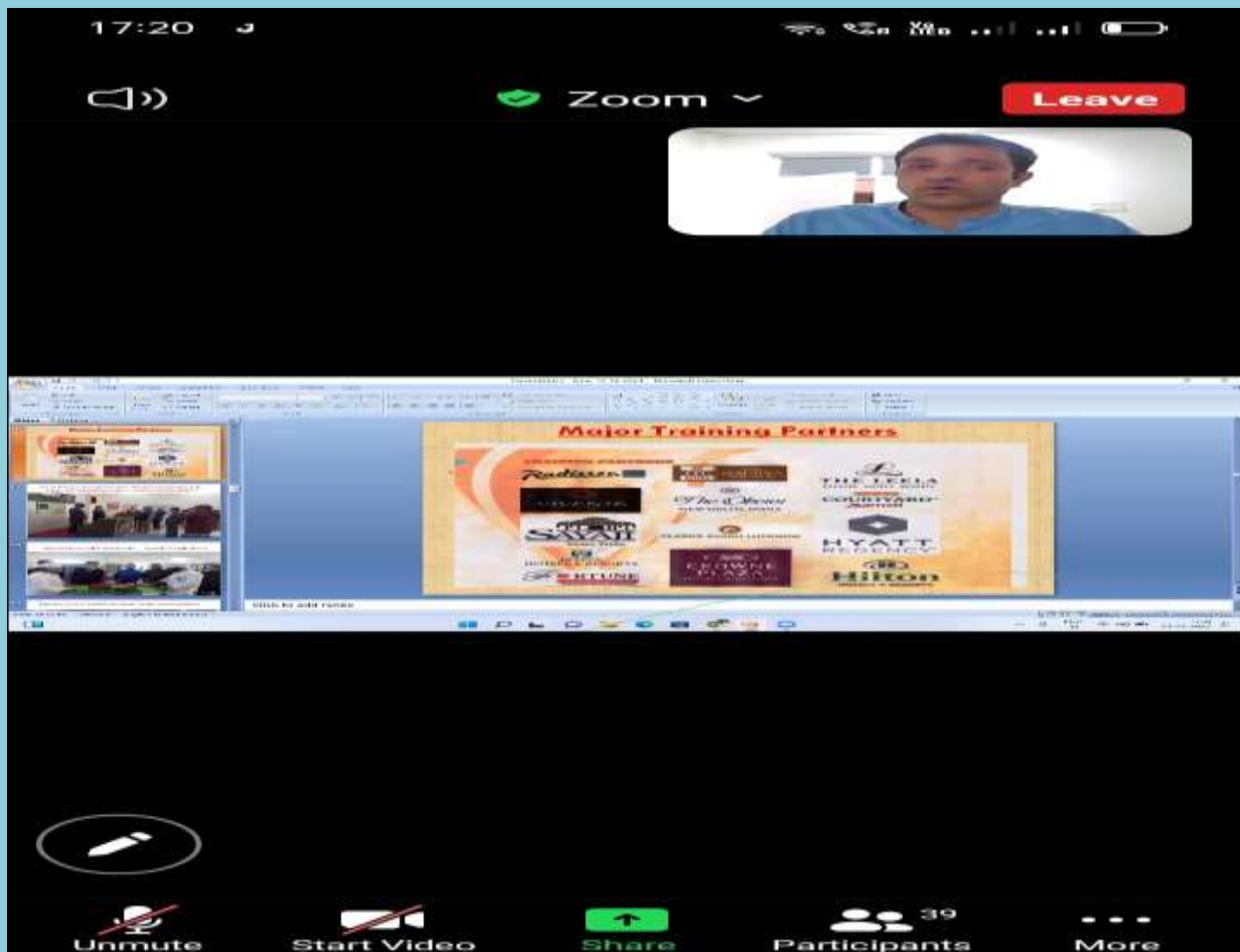
A fresh batch of 30 students under CBSP programme in Multi Cuisine Cook has been started at Katra

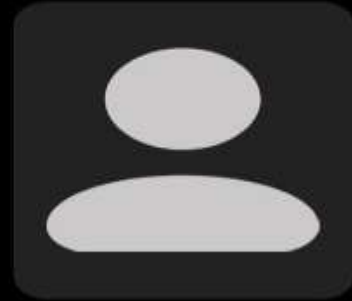
